Kent is the largest exhibitor and is sponsoring the Yamaha demo truck. Kent Powersports is owned by recently retired professional baseball player Jeff Kent. Kent spent 17 years in the major leagues and as a career home-run leader among second basemen with 351. He left the Los Angeles Dodgers after four seasons to spend more time with his family.

Henry T. Chriss, founder, designer and bike builder extraordinaire, will be there with his PhatBack™ customization kit to turn your Harley-Davidson touring bike into a custom classic, "old school" style.

After six months of deconstructing, redesigning, and rebuilding his 2005 Harley-Davidson Road King Classic, Henry T. Chriss' newly-designed motorcycle took on the look of classic American-made automobiles from the 1940's and 1950's. The low, long and streamlined appearance was unique, yet recognizable. Chriss said, "I wanted to re-establish that sentimental connection I had with the old school classic cars that I remember and love from the 1940s, 50s and 60s. Cars that had a streamlined, smooth and fluid look with fender skirts and integrated running boards." From there, Old Skool Cycle Werks (OSCW) was born and the first PhatBack™!



Henry's flagship product, coined the PhatBack™, is a one-piece, hand-laid fiberglass body kit that allows you to customize your own motorcycle. In about an hour, you can go from stock to custom, at an affordable price, in your garage. The PhatBack gives you the look of a fullscale custom bike, without spending \$100,000. Even better, you can enjoy riding it instead of keeping it in the garage and only taking it out for the shows. You can install the kit on your Harley-Davidson touring bike in about an hour, with no modifications to your frame. The one-piece kit is easily installed with two bolts under the seat and two screws on each of the running boards that rest on the stock foot boards. Everything else is just pressure-fit onto the frame. Once installed, the kit comes off in two minutes, giving you full access to the bike's rear mechanicals. If you need to service your bike on the road, you now have more access than you would with a stock bike

OSCW is participating in the South Texas Motorcycle Show because it will allow them to introduce their products in a market that consists of a large number of metric bike motorcycle enthusiasts. They hope



attendees of the show will provide valuable feedback before designing and fabricating the prototype for the first metric kits for Honda VTX, Suzuki Boulevard, Kawasaki Vulcan and Yamaha V-Star. Specifically, they are looking for what the metric rider wants before designing their prototype. The

Texas market is unique and diverse -- culturally and ethnically -- which translates to a plethora of design ideas.
